All citizens are advised that the adoption of the proposed text amendment could affect: the use of any property located within the City; the definitions of words as applied to the zoning and use of any property located within the City; the display of any signs within the City; procedures contained in the Zoning Ordinance; and other conditions, requirements or allowed uses/items contained in the Articles of the Zoning Ordinance listed above.
