2040 COMPREHENSIVE
PLAN**

The Public is hereby notified that on **Monday, December 10, 2018, at 7:30 p.m.** at Snellville City Hall, 2342 Oak Road, Snellville, the Mayor and City Council will hold a public hearing to receive comments for the 2040 Comprehensive Plan. The purpose of this hearing is to brief the community on the contents of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan, provide an opportunity for citizens to make final suggestions, additions or revisions, and notify the community of when the 2040 Plan will be submitted to the Atlanta Regional Commission and Georgia Department of Community Affairs for review. The document has been prepared following the Rules of Georgia Department of Community Affairs Standards and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning.

Jacobs Engineering will present the draft 2040 Comprehensive Plan which addresses land use, transportation, housing, and economic development. The presentation will include a discussion of Needs and Opportunities, Community Vision and Goals, proposed changes to the Future Development Map and Future Land Use Map, and major items for the five-year Community Work Program.

At the December 10th meeting the Mayor and Council will consider a Transmittal Resolution to forward the 2040 Comprehensive Plan document to the Atlanta Regional Commission for review and approval. All interested parties are encouraged to attend the hearing and will have an opportunity to provide comment and ask questions of the consultant team and City officials and staff.

The 2040 Comprehensive Plan will be on file at Snellville City Hall, 2342 Oak Road, Snellville, Georgia, and may be viewed by the public between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. www.snellville2040.org
