**CITY OF SNELLVILLE  
LCI 5-YEAR PLAN UPDATE**

The Public is hereby notified that on **March 11, 2019, at 7:30 p.m.** at Snellville City Hall, 2342 Oak Road, Snellville, the Mayor and Council, will hold a public hearing to receive comments for the 5-Year update to the 2003 Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) plan.

The LCI is a grant program funded by the Atlanta Regional Commission to incentivize cities to re-envision their communities as vibrant, walkable places that offer increased mobility options, encourage healthy lifestyles, and provide improved access to jobs and services. Each LCI area is guided by a plan, outlining key strategies and a five-year work program. The City of Snellville joined the LCI program in 2003 with a plan for the Towne Center area and last updated the plan in 2013. This plan provides a vision and strategic guidance for the Towne Center LCI area.

This 5-year update builds on previous efforts, validating the vision, adjusting for recent developments, and outlining a work program for the next five years. It includes: Key Issues and Opportunities; Validation of Vision and Goals; Evaluation and Appraisal Report; Implementation Plan; and 5-Year Action Plan.

The January 2019 draft LCI 5-Year Update is on file at Snellville City Hall, 2342 Oak Road, Snellville, Georgia, and may be viewed by the public between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The draft is also available on the project website [www.snellville2040.org](http://www.snellville2040.org).

The Mayor and Council will consider the recommendations by the Planning Commission, conduct a public hearing and receive comments, and take action for the adoption of the final draft of the LCI 5-Year Plan Update. 928-586838, 2/20
