#### I. Call to Order

## **II. Old Business**

Lisa asked for approval of the January 4, 2022 minutes. Alice motioned for approval, Nicole seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Vote was 2 in favor-present, 1 in favor via phone, 1 in favor via notarized document, 0 opposed, 2 vacancies.

## **III. New Business**

a. Update on Mayor/Council adding 2<sup>nd</sup> non-resident member to the Park Advisory Board. Lisa proposed the additional non-resident member at the City Retreat.

## b. ATHLETICS/FIELD RENTALS

- 1. Spring leagues –registrations and practices have started; Soccer games start this Saturday. Flag Football is end of March.
- 2. eSports Leagues-finished winter and going into spring; GRPA is providing resources. Competing from anywhere Adult & Youth
- 3. Tennis-Instructors (Anthony & Wade). Numbers are high. Lisa approached USTA to evaluate cracks in courts. Tennis summer camp added last summer.
- 4. Wellness Soccer/Softball ongoing

## c. SENIOR CENTER

1. Center is fully open. AARP tax preparation is not at the center-referrals to Bethesda Park.

- 2. Two day trips scheduled and one overnight trip. Alice asked about exercise classes-Lisa said the aerobics are at Senior Center now but back in the park in March.
- 3. Lisa stated we had initial age to join Senior Center at 55 due to the CDBG grant rules-around 500 members. Alice motioned to reduce age for membership to 50 at the Senior Center. Motion was approved.
