## DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY CITY OF SNELLVILLE, GA SPECIALLY CALLED MEETING

### **Meeting Minutes**

November 3, 2016

#### I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 PM. Directors present: Buddy Scott, Nelson Williams, Matt Czarick, Dan LeClair, Tom Witts and Gary Parker. Also present was Eric Van Otteren.

#### II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES and FINANCIAL REPORT

The Directors unanimously approved the September 15 meeting minutes. Dan shared the DDA has a bank balance of \$93,063.89 and is anticipating an Excise Tax check from the city in the approximate amount of \$14,700. From this amount, IMG's bill, in the amount of \$12,000 will be paid. This leaves an approximate balance of \$95,763.

#### III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Directors voted to go into Executive Session to discuss real property issues.

#### IV. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Discussion of retreat and update session with Jim O'Bryan.-Eric reminded the Directors of the Nov. 30 retreat date. Planning is going well.
- B. Update on Primary Gateway sign at 2992 Main Street.-The Directors discussed the recommendation to build a larger monument sign as the originally proposed monument sign did not have enough mass for the selected location. The directors approved the new design and a motion was made by Tom Witts to accept the new design and approve the additional cost of \$23,420 as quoted by IMG. The motion was seconded by Matt Czarick. The motion was approved unanimously. Eric will talk with Craig Johnson about a new mock-up illustrating the new monument size.
- C. Discussion of the proposed LCI grant application.-Eric reviewed the ARC 2017 LCI Update Plan application. Eric had prepared a draft of an application. The Directors reviewed the draft and discussed the need for a \$40,000 match. Eric is to review the application with the City Manager and request a commitment from the city for the \$40,000 in matching funds. Gary Parker made a motion to submit the LCI application as proposed and reviewed; and motioned that the DDA offer a commitment of \$40,000 in matching funds to the \$150,000 requested from ARC. The total funding amount for the LCI application is \$190,000. Tom Witts seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. Eric is to talk with the City Manager regarding the matching funds. Eric is also to prepare a completed application for the Mayor and Council Members to review.
- D. Discussion of Towne Center planning.-Eric shared an update of The Towne Center @ Snellville progress and activities.

#### V. NEW BUSINESS

A. DDA appointed member to the Snellville Tourism and Trade Board for re-appointment for the 2017 term.-The Directors discussed the opportunity to appoint a board member to the Snellville Tourism and Trade (STAT) organization board. The motion was made by Nelson to re-appoint Don Britt as the DDA's appointment to the STAT Board. Dan LeClair seconded the motion. There was some discussion. The motion was approved unanimously.

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### VI. ANNOUNCEMENTS

The regular meeting on November 17 is cancelled. The DDA will convene a planning retreat on November 30 at 9:00 AM at the Walton EMC 3645 Lenora Church Rd, Snellville, GA 30039.
