**CALL TO ORDER**

**CITY ATTORNEY'S REPORT**

Attorney Ross advised that the nuisance case for 2468 Mountain View Road is going to Court on July 21<sup>st</sup> and that the intent of the owners is to abandon the property. Discussion followed about the status of the property owner and getting him assistance.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS**

Review of the Park Master Plan Update [Bender]

Parks Director Platt went over the current plan and accomplishments and reviewed the concept plan for Phase III which was reassessed in 2019.

Update of Ongoing Projects [Bender]

City Manager Sanders gave an update on the Towne Center progress and advised they closed on the Library parcel. He reviewed several other ongoing issues.

Discussion of the Noise Ordinance Updates [Schulz]

Attorney Ross handed out a red lined version of the draft ordinance for review. He asked about revisiting the distance requirements. Discussion followed and Chief Perry was asked to have the Police report on anything in the ordinance that may be an enforcement issue.


