"The Prince of Egypt"



For emergency only, please contact us immediately and, if possible, we will do our best to reimburse you or credit your account.

NOTE: For overnight trips only, we take cash, money orders or checks which are to be written to Delrose Johnson, our Travel Club President.

Credit card payments are Not Accepted for overnight. Monthly payments are required. Otherwise, your name will go on the Waitlist after 2 months of non-payment. Deposits are subject to being non-refundable and have a different criteria based on the trip taken.
