SECTION I – GENERAL INFORMATION

- A state license must be obtained before any alcoholic beverage can be served or sold in the City of Snellville. Contact the Alcohol & Tobacco Division of the Georgia Department of Revenue at (877) 423-6711 or <u>atdiv@dor.ga.gov</u>
- Read and understand the City's Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance. Licensees to maintain a copy of the Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance and employees shall be familiar with the terms and conditions of the ordinance.
- Please see the attached Alcoholic Beverage Serving/Sales (Hours) Schedule.
- Before any license can be issued, you must contact the following departments for your inspection and permit/license and Certificate of Occupancy:
 - (a). Gwinnett Co. Fire Marshal's Office (Life Safety Certificate of Occupancy): (678) 518-6000
 - (b). Gwinnett Co. Health Department (on premises consumption only): (770) 963-5132
 - (c). Georgia Department of Agriculture (retail package dealers only): (404) 656-3615

□ Where the applicant is a partnership or corporation and if the total number of locations engaged in the sale of alcoholic beverages that is owned by the partnership or corporation is greater than five (5), the district manager and store manager must jointly apply for a license on the corporation's behalf. If five (5) or fewer, then all the partners, officers, and individual stockholders with holdings of greater than 20% in the applicant business must jointly apply for a license on the company's behalf.

A notice of each application to sell distilled spirits by consumption on premises shall be advertised in the official newspaper of the City, once a week for two weeks immediately preceding consideration of the application.

- □ All licenses granted hereunder shall expire on December 31st of each year. Licenses shall continue in effect from December 31st until December 31st of subsequent years; provided the renewal procedures are followed pursuant to the terms of the ordinance. Applications for renewal must be filed no less than 60 days nor more than 90 days prior to expiration.
- All licenses granted hereunder shall be for the calendar year. For an initial application, the license fee shall be prorated based on the quarter of the year in which the City receives the application, except for applications for a temporary license, which shall not be prorated. The four quarters of the year shall be deemed to start on the first of January, April, July and October.
- Any person renewing any license hereunder shall pay the required fee, or any portion thereof, after December 31st, shall, in addition to said annual fee and late charges, pay simple interest on the delinquent balance at the annual rate then charged by the IRS on unpaid federal income taxes.

- Certified report of survey from registered land surveyor or professional engineer;
- Copies of: (a) Certificate of Occupancy issued by the Gwinnett County Fire Marshal's Office; (b) Food Service Permit issued by the Gwinnett County Department of Environmental Health (food establishment only); Permit from Georgia Department of Agriculture (grocery and convenience stores).
- Certified scale drawing showing location and distance to closest school buildings, daycare's who offer kindergarten programs, educational buildings, school grounds, colleges and/or any house of worship buildings;
- Evidence of ownership of the building or copy of the lease, if applicant is leasing the building;
- □ If applicant is a franchise, copy of the franchise agreement or contract;
- □ If applicant represents an eating establishment, submit a copy of menu(s);
- □ If applicant represents a private club, submit minutes of annual meeting setting salaries for members, officers, agents, or employees;
- □ If applicant represents a partnership, submit copy of partnership agreement;
- Projected purchases/projected gross sales (if applying for distilled spirits consumption);
- □ If applicant represents a corporation, include articles of incorporation; and certificate of corporation.

- (f) The Craft Beer Market licensee shall provide a variety of pre-packaged snacks available for purchase and consumption. The licensee shall also offer some snacks to patrons free of charge; and
- (g) A Bottle Shop may sell and serve beer and wine by the drink for consumption on the premises; and sell wine and beer by the package.

8. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR HOME BREW SPECIAL EVENT:

- (a) At the home-brew special event, home-brewed malt beverages shall not be sold, offered for sale, or made available for consumption by the general public.
- (b) Provide a Letter of Intent which fully describes the nature of the proposed event, including the description of the designated event area.

9. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR HOTEL/MOTEL IN-ROOM SERVICE:

- (a) The sale of beer and/or wine by "in-room service" shall be subject to all restrictions and limitations relative to the retail sale of any alcoholic beverages, except as provided otherwise in this article; and
- (b) Keys for "in-room service" shall only be sold to guests between the hours of 7:00 a.m. until 12:00 midnight Monday through Saturday.

10. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ART SHOP:

- (a) ART SHOP: A retail business located in the BN, BG, or HSB districts devoted exclusively to providing art education that is limited to instruction in painting, sculpture, and similar crafts; or to selling and displaying portraits, paintings, sculptures, and similar art work and crafts. An Art Shop may sell art supplies in addition to providing art education or to offering artwork for sale. An Art Shop shall not allow activities that would cause the business to be an "adult entertainment establishment" as defined in Chapter 10, Article II of the City Code of Snellville.
- (b) BRING YOUR OWN BOTTLE: Facilities licensed as an Art Shop under Chapter 6 of the City Code of Snellville may allow customers to bring in a bottle or bottles of wine and/or beer subject to the specific provisions governing the operation of an Art Shop.
- (c) Applicant understands and acknowledges the following (please initial each):

The retail business establishment is located on property which is zoned BN,
BG, or HSB;

The retail business establishment is devoted exclusively to providing art education that is limited to instruction in painting, sculpture, and similar crafts; or selling and displaying portraits, paintings, sculptures, and similar art work and crafts and may sell art supplies in addition to providing art education or to offering art work for sale;

10. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR ART SHOP (continued):

(c) Applicant understands and acknowledges the following (please initial each):

 An Art Shop licensed under Chapter 6 of the City Code of Snellville may allow customers to bring in a bottle or bottles of wine and beer to be consumed on the premises. The customer must remove any unconsumed wine or beer from the premises before leaving;
 An Art Shop shall not store, keep, or handle any wine or beer belonging to the customer, and no owner, employee or agent of the Art Shop shall pour or have any contact with the wine or beer;
 No customer of an Art Shop shall consume more than two (2) six (6) ounce servings of wine or tw0 (2) twelve (12) ounce servings of beer during a three hour period or four (4) six (6) ounce servings of wine or four (4) twelve (12) ounce servings of beer within a single business day;
 The brown-bagging of wine and/or beer in an Art Shop shall be subject to Chapter 6 of the City Code of Snellville and to State law, and no one who is under twenty-one (21) years of age or intoxicated persons may consume wine or beer in an Art Shop; and
 An Art Shop may serve food provided it meets all of the requirements provided in the City Code of Snellville and Gwinnett County Department of Environmental Health.

11. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICE LICENSE:

- (a) A Personal Service License to sell beer and/or wine by the drink at nail salons, hair salons, or beauty shops, provided the serving of the beer and/or wine is an act of hospitality and clearly a secondary function of the business.
- (b) Applicant understands and acknowledges the following (please initial each):

The serving of beer and/or wine is an act of hospitality and clearly a secondary
function of the business;

- Applicant must charge a reasonable fee for each serving of beer and/or wine and meet the records and retention requirements of Sec. 5-1 (b);
- Any holder of a license issued pursuant to this ordinance is required to apply or and obtain an alcoholic beverage license from the State of Georgia before any sales commence; and

Applicant shall not purchase alcoholic beverages from any person, firm or corporation other than a wholesaler licensed under this ordinance.

12. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR TEMPORARY SPECIAL EVENT:

- (a) A temporary permit may be issued to any person, from or corporation, for a period not to exceed three (3) days for an approved small or special event, and no more than six (6) such permits may be issued to the applicant organization in any one (1) calendar year;
- (b) Provide a Letter of Intent which fully describes the nature of the proposed event, including the description of the designated event area, handling and storage of alcoholic beverages and the distribution of alcoholic beverages;
- (c) The permittee shall be responsible for compliance with all aspects of the Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance and state law, and shall be liable for infractions thereof;
- (d) The chief of police or his designee may immediately revoke any temporary license for a special event if it is determined continued alcohol sales may endanger the health, welfare or safety of the public; and
- (e) As a condition on the issuance of a temporary special event permit, the permittee shall indemnify and hold the City of Snellville harmless from claims, demand or cause of action which may arise from activities associated with the special event.

13. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR WINE TASTING EVENT LICENSE:

- (a) The holder of a license to sell packaged wine in the City of Snellville who is in compliance with all applicable provisions of the City Ordinances may apply for a Wine Tasting Event License which allows for samples of wine to be served in conjunction with an educational presentation related to wine pursuant to the following requirements:
- (b) Applicant understands and acknowledges the following (please initial each):
 - Wine tasting events can occur no more often than one day per week with a duration of no more than two hours per day;
 - An educational program related to wine must be conducted in conjunction with any wine tasting event;
 - _____ Samples shall not exceed two (2) ounces, and no attendee may be served more than six (6) ounces of wine during the event;
 - _____ Samples shall only be poured by an employee of licensee;
 - The licensee shall provide a variety of prepackaged snacks available for purchase and consumption. The licensee shall also offer some snacks to patrons free of charge;
 - _____ The application process for a wine tasting event license shall follow the same procedures and requirements for other licenses required under the ordinance;
 - Licensees must comply and stay in compliance with all applicable state laws and regulations of the State of Georgia in order to maintain its license; and
 - _____ Nothing in this section is intended to preclude a licensee from charging a fee for the event and/or sample.

PREMISE AND STRUCTURE

14. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR FARM WINERY TASTING ROOM LICENSE:

- (a) A farm winery licensed by the state and possessing a valid Farm Winery Manufacturers License from the City of Snellville, may apply for a Farm Winery tasting Room License which allows the Farm Winery to provide samples of such wine to the public and for retail sale as provided by law. Samples of wine can be given complimentary or for a fee pursuant to the following procedures and requirements:
- (b) Applicant understands and acknowledges the following (please initial each):
 - the application process for a farm winery tasting room license shall follow the same procedures and requirements for other licenses required under this ordinance;
 - _____ Samples shall not exceed two (2) ounces, and no customer may be served more than six (6) ounces of wine within a 24-hour period;
 - Licensees must comply and stay in compliance with all applicable state laws and regulations of the State of Georgia in order to maintain its license; and
 - The licensee shall provide a variety of prepackaged snacks available for purchase and consumption. The licensee shall also offer some snacks to patrons free of charge;
